

Bealings School Policy with regard to the Covid-19 virus.

- 1. We will follow PHE and DFE advice.
- 2. We will keep parents and carers informed of all relevant information when we receive it and are confident of its reliability.
- 3. We ask parents and carers to share with the school any information about self isolation, symptoms or confirmed infection within their family.
- 4. We expect parents and carers to follow Government advice and not to send any child to school if they have any symptoms of the virus "however mild". Symptoms are: a new persistent cough, fever or shortness of breath, loss or change of taste or smell.
- 5. Our staff will also self isolate in the event they display any of these symptoms.
- 6. If the staff think that any child shows any of these symptoms while at school we will ask parents/carers to remove them immediately.
- 7. We are not permitted to close the whole school unless we are advised to do so by PHE.
- 8. Parents should be prepared that whole bubbles are likely to close if a positive case within the bubble is identified.
